Ea /West and Arms Control

- recall very useful discussion with Mitterrand in London immediately after Reykjavik;
- commend firm and realistic speech by French Foreign Minister;
- account of Washington talks and conclusions;
- can't move back from agreed positions on INF and 50% reductions. Mitterrand appeared to accept these in London;
- need to keep up pressure on Americans and ensure that Camp David conclusions are reflected in NATO communiques;
- press Russians to break linkage of INF with SDI;
- welcome bilateral discussions between European governments but need to be cautious about giving appearance of Europe ganging up on US;
- [with Chirac] understand likely to visit Moscow;
- leave them to raise nuclear cooperation.

European Council

- opening session to concentrate on Business and Jobs Not create unrealistic expectations. No additional expenditure;
- concentrate on job-start, retraining, role of small businesses;
- have written about need to unblock proposals on <u>Internal Market</u>. Everyone to agree to give up their reservations;
- also plan discussion of frontier controls, immigration, drugs and terrorism;
- must resist pressure for bigger <u>Community R&D</u> programme, in view of constantly rising agricultural expenditure. Our limit is 4.2 bn ecu;
- avoid substantive discussion at this Council of ex novo review of Community finances. Delors to make brief statement;
- discussion of East/West relations over dinner.

European Community

- concerned by French opposition to modest steps on access to cheaper air fares. Hope French will agree to widen the conditions for cheaper fares, which will be reflected in bigger traffic. If no agreement, legal steps likely;
- also need a Community effort to confront protectionism on <u>shipping</u> and support European shipping. Measures due to come to Transport Council in December.
