PRIME MINISTER'S MEETING WITH PRESIDENT MATTERRAND: 23 MARCH 1987

SUMMARY

1. MITTERRAND'S STOCK IS HIGH AFTER A YEAR OF COHABITATION. NO DECISION YET ON HIS CANDIDACY FOR NEXT YEAR'S ELECTIONS. HE IS DEEPLY UNTERESTED IN PROGRESS ON ARMS CONTROL, THOUGH WELL AWARE OF THE DANGERS. MEDIOCRE PERFORMANCE OF FRENCH ECONOMY. HOSTAGES HN LEBANON A PREOCCUPATION.

INTERNAL POLITICS

- 2. THE PRIME MINNISTER WILL MEET THE PRESIDENT SHORTLY AFTER THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF COHABITATION. MITTERRAND HAS SO FAR EMERGED WELL FROM THES EXPERIENCE WHICH MANY FEARED, AND SOME (HINCLUDING BARRE) PREDICTED, WOULD BE DAMAGING FOR THE PRESIDENCY. HE HIS GIVEN CREDIST FOR ENABLISHE AN AWKWARD ARRANGEMENT TO WORK, AND FOR HIS JUDGEMENT ON WHERE TO INSIST ON HIS PRESHIDENTHAL PREROGATIVES AND WHERE TO BOW TO THE GOVERNMENT. HE HAS BEEN PART HOULARLY FIRM IN TRYING TO ASSERT HIS CONTINUED PRE-EMPNENCE IN THE FOREIGN POLICY AND DEFENCE FHELDS. IN PRACTICE THE GOVERNMENT TRIMS INTO LINE TO AVOID OPEN DIVERGENCE WITH HIM WHEN HE PRESSES A POINT OF VIEW ON FOREIGN POLICY OR DEFENCE, BUT IT IS CHIRAC WHO HAS HES HANDS ON THE LEVERS OF POWER.
- 3. MITTERRAND'S POPULARIETY HAS INCREASED SINCE LAST MARCH (HE NOW. ENJOYS A 50 PER CENT APPROVAL RATHING), AND HIS SUPPORTERS WANT HIM TO RUN FOR RE-ELECTION NEXT YEAR. NO-ONE KNOWS WHETHER HE WILL FINALLY DECIDE TO DO SO (PERHAPS NOT MATTERRAND HIMSELF). HE WOULD BE BY FAR THE SOCHALIST PARTY'S STRONGEST CANDIDATE. AT 71 HE MANGHT IN THE END PREFER TO STAND ASIDE, CONFIDENT OF HASTORY'S VERDICT ON THE SEVEN YEAR TERM HE WILL HAVE COMPLETED, BUT HE SHOWS NO LOSS OF ZEST FOR THE FRENCH POLITICAL GAME AND THE SAFEST ASSUMPTION IS THAT HE COULD BE IN OFFICE FOR MANY MORE YEARS.

EAST-WEST

4. UNLIKE CHIRAC, MITTERRAND HAS AT PRESENT NO FIRM PLANS FOR A MEETING WITH GORBACHEV THIS YEAR, BUT HE HAD LONG TALKS WITH HIM DURING THREE SUMMET MEETINGS BETWEEN 1984 AND 1986. W BELWEVE HE SHARES THE PREVAMELING ANALYSIS HERE THAT GORBACHEV'S MAIN OBJECTIVE IS TO GET THE SOVIET ECONOMY MOVING AND AVOID FALLING FURTHER BEHIND THE WEST IN THE TECHNOLOGICAL RACE: AND THAT, TO THAT END, HE WS PREPARED TO TAKE QUITE RADICAL STEPS BY SOVIET STANDARDS, THOUGH FALLING WELL SHORT OF A CHANGE OF SYSTEM. MITTERRAND HAS EXPRESSED THE VIEW THAT GORBACHEV IN SINCERELY INTERESTED IN PURSUING

DISARMAMENT IN ORDER TO RELEASE RESOURCES FOR INTERNAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. ELYSEE ADVISERS, HOWEVER, CAUTITON AGAINST THINKING THAT FUNDAMENTAL SOWNET DIPLOMATIC OBJECTIVES HAVE CHANGED, AND WARN THAT GORBACHEY'S TACTICAL FLEXIBILITY GREATLY UNCREASES THE CHALLENGE FOR THE WEST.

5. MITTERRAND DISLIPKED THE QUAR'S 28 FEBRUARY COMMENT ON GORBACHEV, WHICH HE THOUGHT FELL INTO A TRAP BY APPEARING TO BE OPPOSED TO DISARMAMENT AS SUCH AND BY DIVIDING FRANCE FROM THE OTHER EUROPEANS. GIRAUD'S SUBSEQUENT TALK (IN PRIVATE) OF A QUOTE MUNNICH UNQUOTE HE REGARDS AS TOTALLY MISTAKEN. MITTERRAND'S OWN PRESENTATION HAS BEEN VERY CLOSE TO HMG'S PUBLIC LIME: ELYSEE OFFICIALS SAY THAT HE ADMIRED YOUR STATEMENT OF 2 MARCH. THE LATEST FEAR AT THE ELYSEE, HOWEVER, AFTER A WISHT TO WASHINGTON BY ATTALP, IS THAT THE AMERICANS MAY BE TOO READY TO MAKE CONCESSIONS ON SRINE. MITTERRAND MAY RAISE THIS WATH THE PRIME MENHISTER.

6. ONE CONSEQUNCE OF THE . THE DEBATE HAS BEEN YET GREATER EMPHASHS HERE ON EUROPEAN COOPERATION ON SECURITY ISSUES. AFTER MR YOUNGER'S VISHT ON 9-10 MARCH, OUR OWN BILATERAL COOPERATION IS SEEN GENERALLY AS PROGRESSING WELL. YOUR SPEECH IN BRUSSELS ON 16 MARCH HAS ATTRACTED FAVOURABLE PRESS MENT-ION. MITTERRAND HIMSELF HAS BEEN CONCERNED TO STAY IN THE LEAD OF THOSE CALLING FOR EUROPEAN COOPERATION. AFTER THE PRIME MINISTER'S VISIT, HE IS TO SEE KOHL ON 28 MARCH, AND HE VOICED SUPPORT FOR DELORS'S CALL EARLIER THIS WEEK FOR A SPECIFAL EUROPEAN COUNCIL TO BE DEVOTED TO SECURITY QUESTIONS.

FRENCH ECONOMY

7. THE PICTURE FOR THE GOVERNMENT IS MIXED, WHITH SOME OBVIOUS ACHIEVEMENTS (WIDE-RANGING LIBERALISATION MEASURES AND AN IMPRESSIVE START TO PRIVATISATION) BALANCED BY DISAPPOINTING RESULTS ON GROWTH, TRADE AND UNEMPLOYMENT. THE GOVERNMENT HAVE HAD TO ACCEPT THAT SHORT-TERM ECONOMIC PROSPECTS ARE MEDIOCRE AT BEST. IN KEEPING WITH HIS STAND OF LEAVING THE GOVERNMENT TO EXERCISE HTS RESPONSIBILITIES IN INTERNAL AFFAIRS, MITTERRAND HAS NOT CRITICISED THE MAIN LINES OF ECONOMIC POLICY. BUT HE HAS REFUSED TO SIGN ORDONNANCES AND THUS FORCED THE GOVERNMENT TO LEGISLATE IN AREAS WHERE HE HAS CONSIDERED THAT HIS OWN PREVIOUS POLINTICS WERE BEING UNDONE, MICLUDING PRIVATISATION AND MEASURES TO LIBERALISE THE LABOUR MARKET. WHILE THESE HAVE BEEN SYMBOLIC GESTURES RATHER THAN REAL OBSTACLES IN THE WAY OF GOVERNMENT OBJECTIVES, THEY HAVE SERVED MITTERRAND'S PURPOSE OF KEEPING HIM CLEAR OF POSSIBLE BLAME FOR ANY ECONOMIC FAILURES. NF HE DECYDES TO RUN HE WHLL NO BOURT SAVAGE THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES AND RECORD.

8. MITTERRAND HAS CONTINUED TO PORTRAY HIMSELF AS ENTHUSHAST-ICALLY PRO-EUROPEAN, MAKING AN IMPLIECHT CONTRAST WHITH CHIRAC'S TRADITIONALLY LUKEWARM ATTITUDE. HIS PHILOSOPHICAL SPEECH AT CHATHAM HOUSE ON EUROPE'S FUTURE SHOULD BE SEEN AT LEAST PARTLY IN THIS CONTEXT. THERE HAS BEEN LITTLE OPEN DISSENSION ABOUT SPECIFIC

EUROPEAN MISSUES BUT MATTERRAND HAS NEVERTHELESS MANAGED TO CONVEY
THE IMPRESSION THAT HE REGARDS THE GOVERNMENT'S ATTIMUDE AS
PENNY-PUNCHING IN SOME AREAS, EG THE R AND D FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME,
AND LACKING IN DRIVE AND IMAGINATION.

MIDDLE EAST

9. ON 23 MARCH THE THIRD DEADLINE SET BY THE ORGANISATION FOR REVOLUTIONARY JUSTICE FOR THE FRENCH HOSTAGE, NORMANDIN, EXPLIES, AND THE SUBJECT WILL BE IN THE FOREFRONT OF FRENCH MINDS. MAITTERRAND HAS GIVEN A FIRMER IMPRESSION IN HIS PUBLIC STATEMENTS ON THE HOSTAGES AND TERRORISM THAN CHIRAC, BUT HAS APPARENTLY STOOD BACK FROM THE DAY TO DAY DECISIONS ON LEBANON.
