GORBACHEV VISIT

1. I enclose copies of the printed programme together with the final version of the administrative plan for the Gorbachev visit. The latter sets out in detail the ceremonial for the various events on the programme. If however there are any points on which you would like further clarification, please contact either myself or Clive Almond in Protocol Department.
2. We have made contingency arrangements to use Gatwick or Brize Norton as back-up airports, should Heathrow be closed for any reason.
3. There is still some element of uncertainty regarding the programme for Mr Yakovlev in the afternoon following his attendance at the lunch given by the Secretary of State for Defence and the wreathlaying ceremony at Westminster Abbey. He is provisionally down to participate in the factory visit, but this may be judged too tiring on the day. Mr Yakovlev was seriously wounded during the Second World War and as a result cannot walk upstairs and is dependent on lifts. He can walk on the flat and we have sought to adapt his programme to take account of this disability.

His Excellency Mr M S Gorbachev and Mrs Gorbacheva, His Excellency the Soviet Ambassador and Mr Chernyshev leave the aircraft. They are greeted at the foot of the steps by The Lord Strathclyde on behalf of Her Majesty The Queen. The Lord-in-Waiting will present:

Mr R Baxendale will escort HE Mr M S Gorbachev and the Lord-in-Waiting and The Prime Minister to the point on the carpet, where they will stand whilst the Soviet National Anthem is played. (See diagram at Annex 1)

The party will then proceed through the RAF ceremonial carpet guard to the Special Waiting Room.

2315 The Prime Minister will then travel with HE Mr M S Gorbachev and Mr Denis Thatcher with Mrs Gorbacheva back to the Soviet Residence.

HE Mr M S Gorbachev and Mrs Gorbacheva will be met at the Great West Door of Westminster Abbey by the Dean of Westminster, the Very Reverend Michael Mayne who will present the Canons of Westminster and the Chapter Clerk, and other members of the Collegiate Body.

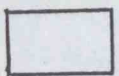

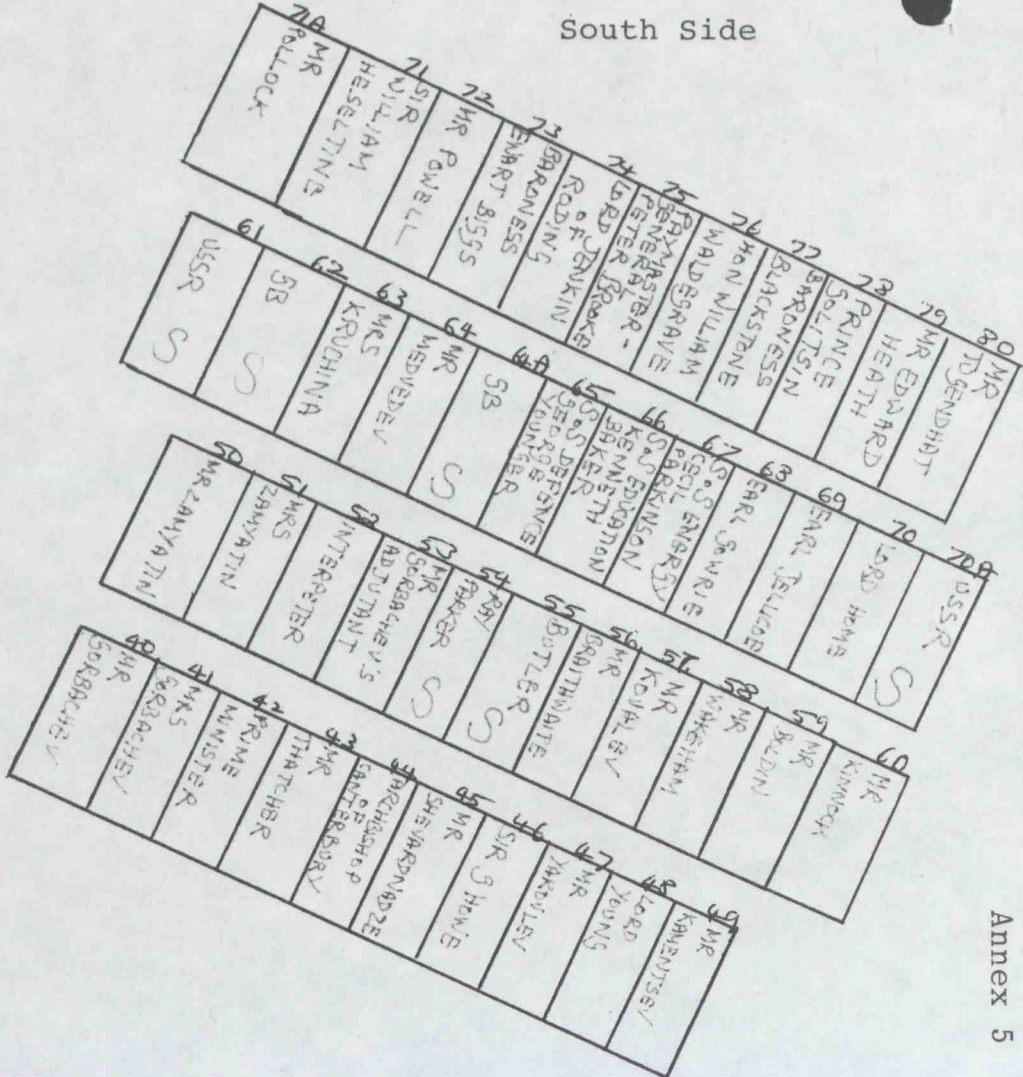
